Education Scotland Support Visit

Last Thursday, 4th September, Alasdair Eadie HM Inspector carried out a planned support visit to the school. He undertook visits to all classes including the Nursery, spoke to pupils and all staff. He summarised that his visit was very positive and noted that there was evidence of significant progress in relation to all areas for improvement identified in the original inspection. The staff are working exceptionally hard to ensure that this progress continues.

Improvement Plan

Since the last newsletter all classes have had discussions as to how we can take forward our main points for action this session. Teachers have also asked parents at the 'meet the teacher' events for your input too. We are now in the process of collating all this information and will share this with you soon.

In order to develop Reading we have organised an author visit for the whole school on Wednesday 1st October.



Award Winning Author Visit - We will be hosting a book reading session by the

award winning Scottish author Stuart Reid on Wednesday 1st October 2014. Stuart's first book *Gorgeous George and the Giant Geriatric Generator* (RRP £7.99) won the Silver Medal at the Forward National Literature Awards. His next two books *Gorgeous George and the Zigzag Zit-faced Zombies* (RRP £6.99) and *Gorgeous George and the Unidentified Unsinkable Underpants* (RRP £6.99) were written to inspire children to read for pleasure.

All books purchased on the day will be signed by the author, with a personal dedication to each pupil. Books will be available individually as priced, two for £12 or all three for school special price of £17.
